OPTION 1 - Health and Safety Requirements

The Health and Safety course covers the sections of Part 3 of the Manitoba Building Code with respect to Fire Safety and Health of the building occupants. The modules address the requirements that relate to the principles of fire safety (detection and alarm, evacuation, prevention, and suppression) and health. This course covers a number of topics including Spatial Separation & Exposure Protection, Exits, Flame Spread Rating, Exiting from Mezzanines, Health Requirements, Fire Alarms, and Detection Systems. This course, originally designed for Plan Examiners and inspectors, is relevant to architects, engineers, Code users, and those who plan to become Certified Manitoba Building Official. The course does **not** include copies of the NBC or NFC.

OPTION 2 – Life Safety Systems

The Life Safety Systems course covers the sections of Part 3 of the Manitoba Building Code with respect to Life Preservation Systems in the case of fire. The modules address the requirements that relate to the principles of fire safety (detection and alarm, prevention, and suppression). This course covers a number of topics including Emergency Power, Fire Alarm & Detection Systems, Inspections, Standpipe & Hose Systems, and Sprinklers. This course, originally designed for Plan Examiners and inspectors, is relevant to architects, engineers, Code users, and those who plan to become Certified Manitoba Building Official. The course does **not** include copies of the NBC or NFC.
