Residential Mechanical Ventilation Installation

This **one day** information session is intended for building officials, home builders and contractors who seek a better understanding of the importance of properly installed ventilation systems in the residential sector. Participants will obtain a detailed overview of the requirements of the nationally recognized CSA Standard F326 "Residential Mechanical Ventilation Systems" and section 9.32 of the Building Code. Demonstration of air-flow testing and depressurization testing will also be included to allow participants to become more familiar with the job related aspects of residential ventilation. **Please note that this is not an HRAI Certification program.**
